Secretary/Treasurer Report-

The minutes of the meeting of the April meeting were reviewed. The minutes were approved with one change. The financials were reviewed. There were no questions and nothing new to report.

Co-ed #13 update-

Tom thanked Secretariat for their attendance at the Ultreya held on April 20th. The next Ultreya will be held on October 12th, after the Co-ed #13 weekend. The target number of participants is 50. The idea would need to be publicized to churches and reunion groups. Gina will explore further.
